The above described puppy is guaranteed to be healthy and free of any canine diseases and intestinal parasites. The canine diseases are Parvo Virus, Corona Virus, Para-influenza, Distemper, Leptospirosis, Hepatitis, and Kennel Cough. The intestinal parasites are roundworms, tapeworms, hookworms, whipworms, and Coccidia. The puppy must be seen by a licensed veterinarian within the 7 day period. If for any reason the puppy has and canine disease(s) and/or parasites, the buyer has 24 hours to contact Keystone Kennel and make arrangements to return the puppy along with a written statement from a licensed veterinarian and all papers belonging to the puppy. At that point Keystone Kennel has the right to a second opinion at no cost to the buyer. If the buyer chooses to keep the puppy then all financial/care responsibilities become that of the buyer and the guarantee is void. If the return is made, the buyer is given a choice of another puppy of equal value when available. At no time does Keystone Kennel assume responsibility for veterinary bills or secondary expenses incurred by the buyer. The purchase of this puppy acknowledges agreement to all terms and conditions set forth in this guarantee.

All of the puppies and adult dogs at Keystone Kennel are registered with the AKC (American Kennel Club). You will be given the AKC registration application either when you pick up the puppy or it will be mailed to you when it is received by Keystone Kennel. Please fill out your portion of the application and mill it to AKC as soon as possible.

All of the puppies and dogs at Keystone Kennel have been de-wormed and vaccinated according to the requirements of their age and will continue to be so long as they remain at Keystone Kennel. The information on the health record reads as to when and with what your puppy has been de-wormed and what vaccinations it has been given. All puppies are taken to a licensed veterinarian at 6 weeks of age for their first shot, a fecal check for worms, and an examination for any abnormalities, genetic faults, etc. All this information is very important to your veterinarian so that he or she can instruct you as to when to bring your puppy back for further vaccinations and other important check-ups.

We and our veterinarian agree that you should wait until your puppy's vaccinations are completed before socializing with unknown puppies and dogs. This would include trips to pet stores, parks and obedience classes. By following these precautions you will help prevent the exposure of your puppy to any canine diseases, illnesses or parasites.

The puppies are all raised on Eukanuba dry small breed puppy food. You will be given a sample when you purchase the puppy and we recommend that you continue to feed this food. If, however you choose not to, we recommend that you change the puppy's food gradually over a 7 to 10 day period by mixing the two foods to avoid any upset stomach or bowels.

Keystone Kennel strongly urges people to spay or neuter your dog. It is healthier for your dog as well as making it easier to train him or her. The personality of your pet will be just as cute and outgoing but without the aggressive or territorial behavior caused by hormones.

Keystone Kennel has been breeding dogs since 1986 and were showing dogs between 1986 and 1994. With over 15 years combined experience working with veterinarians we have increased our veterinary knowledge enabling us to raise healthier dogs. We have been Georgia State licensed since 1995. The state keeps in close contact with all licensed breeders by making random visits to monitor the safety, cleanliness, shelter, and overall well being of all dogs and puppies. Even if you do not buy from us we encourage people to buy from only qualified, state licensed breeders who register their dogs with the AKC.
